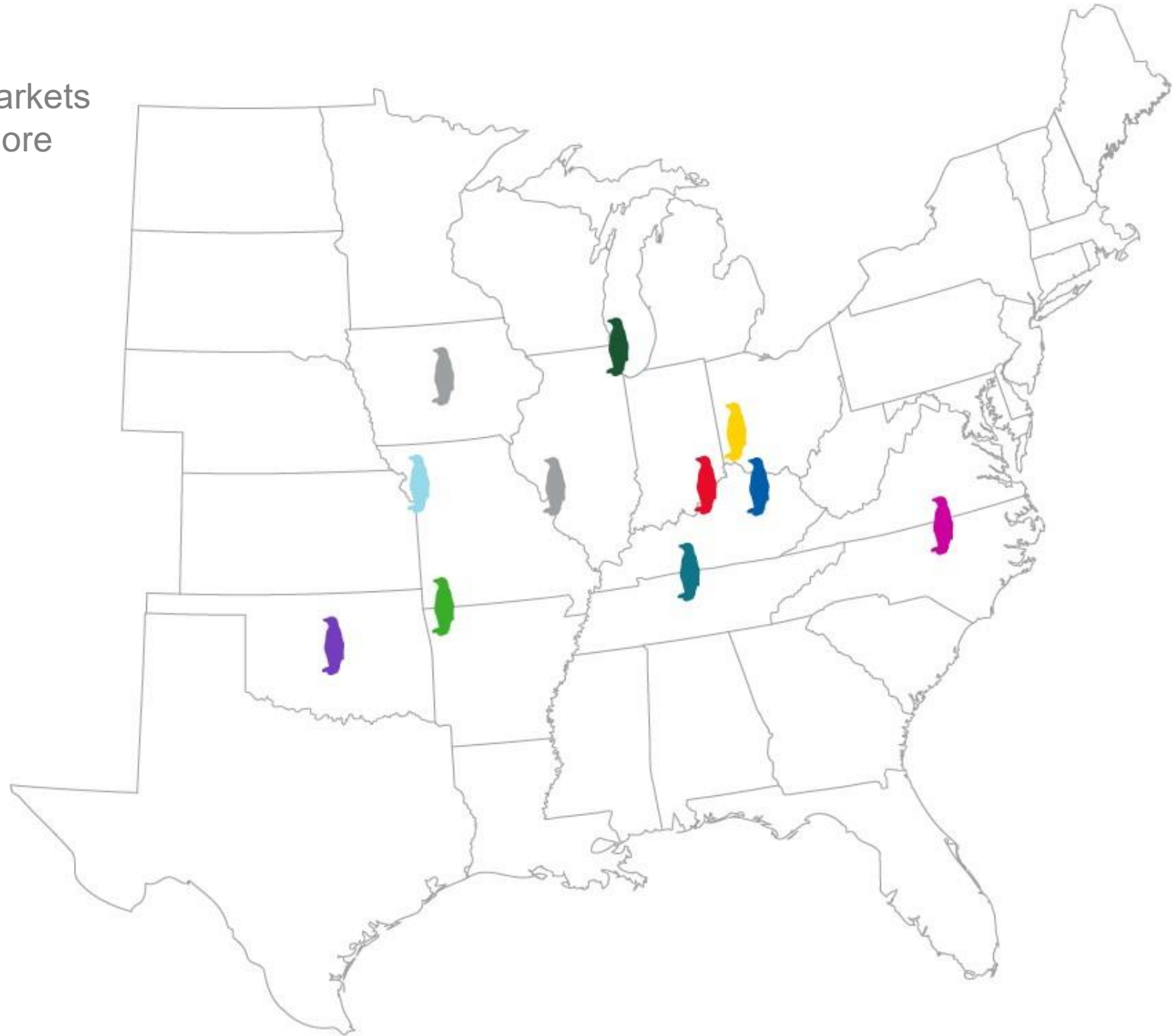

## Cincinnati, Ohio

The Queen City

Cincinnati is known for our rich art culture, endless entertainment, current and historical brewery scene and a recent culinary revolution. Notable attractions include the Cincinnati Zoo, King's Island, Great American Ballpark, Paul Brown Stadium, Cincinnati Museum Center, Cincinnati Art Museum and Findlay Market. The property is a reimagined 100-year-old building originally opened as Hotel Metropole, a swanky all-men's hotel complete with a Turkish bath. Beautiful mosaic tiles, crown molding architecture detail and a 3-story grand spiral staircase were all restored to their original state when the property was reopened in 2012. The hotel also has a rooftop bar and full-service spa.

## Opened in 2012

21c Cincinnati is a one-of-a-kind multi-venue property featuring a world class contemporary art museum, boutique hotel, chef-driven farm to table restaurant, rooftop bar, full-service spa and public art installation in Gano Alley.

Originally opened in 1912, Hotel Metropole was a boutique hotel featuring a grand dining room, a speakeasy style pub in the basement, and a Turkish bath complete with a plunge pool. Christened with a New Year's Eve party, Hotel Metropole was known as the finest hotel of its time, the businessman's "home away from home".

## *Current Exhibition*

Bedecked and bejeweled, the figures populating *Dress Up, Speak Up: Regalia and Resistance* occupy fluid space and time, evoking past and present, fact and fiction, memory and desire, to illuminate the complexity of contemporary identity. Whether clad in the stylized garb of 18<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup>-century Europe, the traditional coverings of ancient religious traditions, or the gender-bending bling of popular culture, these representations of self and other role-play in real time, reaching back through history to address prevailing personal, social, and political challenges. This pantheon of provocative and prophetic personages are adorned to confront, transform, and redefine cultural identity.

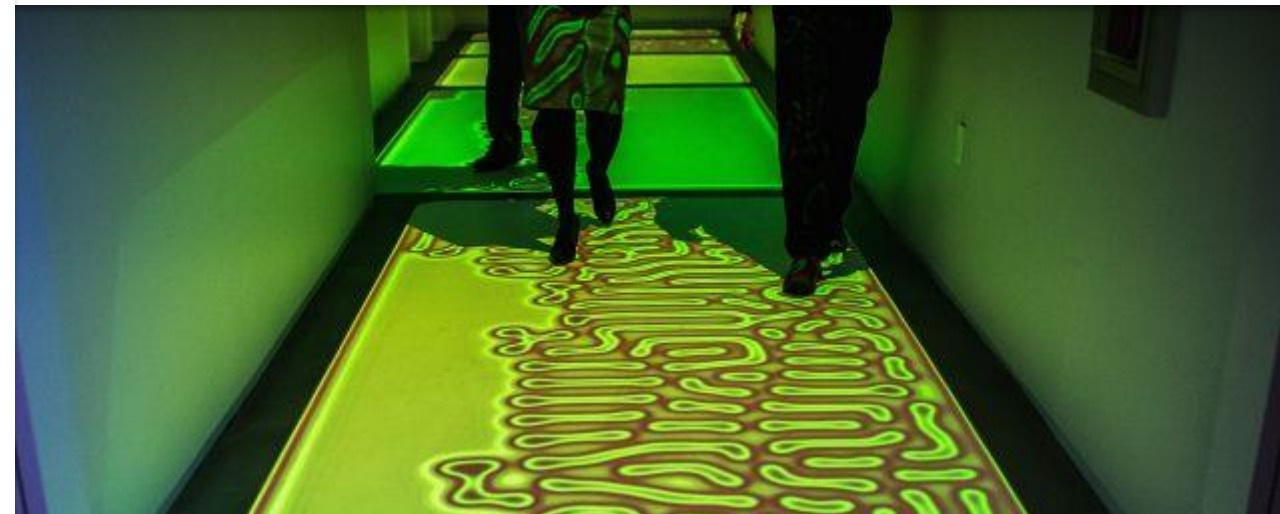


# Museum Information

## *Site-Specific Installations*

At 21c Cincinnati, site-specific, commissioned art installations transform unexpected spaces into experiences. Grimanese Amoros's light sculpture, *Uros*, illuminates a hallway connecting gallery space to the chef-driven restaurant, Metropole. Continuing on the first floor, projected onto the floor leading to the restrooms, is Brian Knep's *Healing Tiles*, a regenerative pool of colors, pattern, and light, which tears apart as each visitor walks across, then rebuilds, though never exactly as before. Galleries on the second floor reveal a shimmering, shifting spectrum of color emanating from the nine-story interior solarium; Astrid Krogh's fiber optic tapestries, *Lightmail*, remind 21c guests that art is all over: above heads, below feet, and everywhere in between.

## *Cultural Programming*
